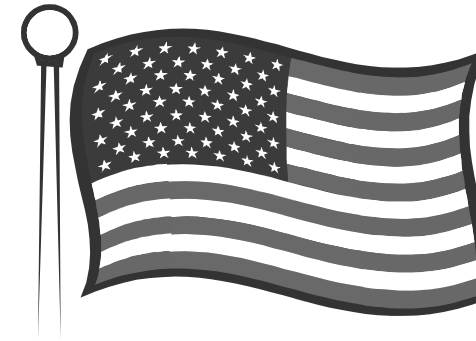

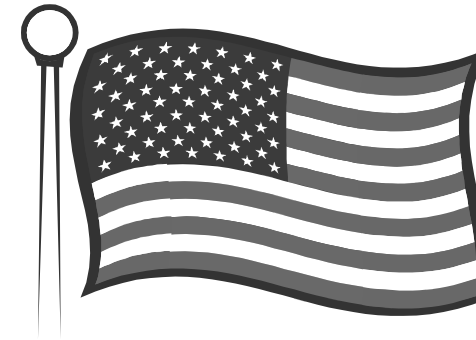

THE SHOEMAN COMETH IN 2009

Turn your used shoes into Fresh Water. This is a project of Eagle Wings Ministries to continue the work of a young Kenyan man, Mr. John Kihumba, who came to the United States to further his education. When he would make trips back to Kenya, he would take with him several pairs of used shoes for his people. George Hutchings became John's mentor and George helped collect his used shoes. Unfortunately, John was killed while in Kenya and George continued the work of sending used shoes to Kenya. No longer can the shoes be accepted into the country, so George has found a way to sell used shoes and in return buy a drilling rig & a towing vehicle to drill much needed water wells in Kenya.

In order to do this, George needs to collect 200,000 pairs of used shoes. They will be sold locally and then shipped to South America's used shoe market for people who cannot afford new shoes, so they barter or purchase used shoes.

You will find a big blue barrel that will be used as a drop location for all your used shoes in the foyer at the front doors. THANK YOU!!!
