THE CROSS

The cross on the altar has been in our Church for many years. It was recently polished and lacquered to help keep its beauty for many more years to come. Maryellen McVicker researched some information about the name that is found on the cross plaque “Ed W. Pfaffenberger” who was a minister of the German Methodist Church in Boonville which closed when WWI caused so much prejudice. Rev. Pfaffenberger died in 1921 so we are assuming the cross dates back to that time. We are not sure how the cross ended up in our Church but we suppose that the Pfaffenbergers started attending church here when the German Methodist Church closed.

Thank you, Trustees and Sharon Mellor, for all the work you did to preserve this part of our church’s heritage and history.

Roger is a 2nd grader. He's a tough little boy who tells his teacher things like, "I'm not doing that" and "I don't care what you say." He's often the ring leader when fights break out, and because he is small, he recruits larger boys to fight with him. He isn't reading and it looks like he will repeat 2nd grade. He was suspended last week when he and two other students skipped a class. They wandered the campus for 15 minutes before being found.

The bright spot in Roger's week is his time with Elizabeth. He is sweet and respectful to her. He is embarrassed when he gets in trouble, because he knows she will be disappointed. They work on reading and talk about making better choices with his behavior. Elizabeth meets with him twice a week whenever possible. His face lights up when he sees her and he asks other people about her.
